Jane Jacobs was a famous urbanologist who lived in Toronto from 1968 until her passing in 2006, a person who was passionate about protecting and enhancing cities from unbridled growth. Alleyway improvements

Within the SAHRA boundaries, there is one north-south alleyway that runs behind stores on Avenue Road between Felbrigg to Haddington and then on to Dunblaine. SAHRA contacted the City's Solid Waste Management office and reported the accumulated litter situation. The City arranged for a special 'spring clean-up' on March 12th. They will monitor the alleyway for clean-up as required. SAHRA has sent a letter to all the shop owners who back onto this alleyway about the special 'spring cleaning' that has been done. We have asked that they keep their area little free / and to send an email to sahratontoronto@rogers.com if the alleyway becomes littered so that we can alert the City.

Graffiti

The police take graffiti very seriously as it can be a first sign of crime increasing in an area; they correlate an increase in crime with graffiti. If not cleaned up right away it sends the message that people in the neighbourhood are not paying attention or they just do not care enough to report it. For example, we have seen increasing graffiti on the Canada Post green boxes.

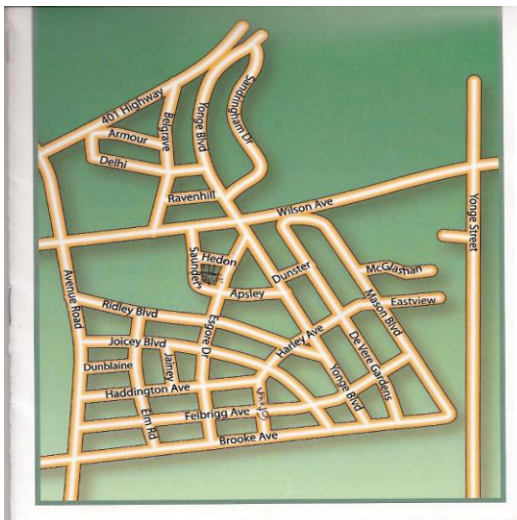
