Bathurst Street Closure - Town Hall & Survey

There is another community meeting planned on Jan 16 from 7:00-9:00 at Beth Tzedec Synagogue, 1700 Bathurst Street, to provide feedback to Metrolinx regarding the planned closure of Bathurst Street at Eglinton.

Metrolinx is saying that closing Bathurst Street completely for a **minimum** of 7 months (they admitted it could go much longer due to the unpredictability of infrastructure work), they will shave 3 months off of overall construction time.

But there are downsides that perhaps do not justify the inconvenience not just to a community, but to the city at large.

Consider that:

- -traffic will be routed through neighbourhoods
- -safety of children is a major concern
- -buses will be routed through neighbourhoods
- -the only way to cross the intersection on foot will require an uphill walk a full block to a light; this is a problem for people with disabilities.
- -the route is a major hub for private and public schools in the neighbourhood
- -alternative routes like Dufferin and Avenue Road will be impacted
- -retailers have struggled to survive over the course of construction, a complete closure will likely cause some to go out of business

TOWN HALL - BATHURST STREET CLOSURE


