

- Elsewhere: Outside of SAHRA's boundaries




Distribution by % of Homes with Email Addresses on File












- Conclusion: Shared responsibility between the City and business owners, leaning towards business owners
- Share with councillor











Current issues for Avenue Road


Dislike conclusions


- Work with councillor on current Avenue Road traffic study

- Litter: Not sure if this is a residential problem. Work with councillor to keep Avenue Road clean: shared responsibility between city and business owners




Did you attend the Avenue Road Fall Fest on October 19, 2019?


Fall Fest suggestions and conclusions


- Work with the councillor (but he needs business owner involvement)

- I am interested in crime info from a wider geographic area (e.g. Bayview to Bathurst; Sheppard to Eglinton)


Conclusions


- Continue to advance green items





- Limited potential for further growth in North subarea

Are there any major issues or concerns that you would like to tell us about?



- ° "I am disappointed about pet owners not cleaning up after their dogs or dropping pet waste into garden waste bags. I am also disappointed that people put their yard waste out days/weeks in advance of pick up."
 - Annual eBlast reminder re proper disposal of pet poop
 - eBlast re putting our yard waste the night before or the morning of pickup
- Parking on south side of Wilson east of Avenue Road: Safety concern where busses need to merge left at the same location as vehicles turn north into the apartment parking lot.
 - Raise with councillor (Traffic & road safety)
- GPS and traffic apps provide routes through our neighbourhood, increasing traffic
 - Raise with councillor (Traffic & road safety)
