



## Development

Avenue Road: Continue existing activities supporting: Village feel, Avenue Road Avenue Study, limited height (biggest concern), limited density, concern of increased traffic

- Contact councillor's office:
  - Too many condos; concerns of small businesses not being able to thrive
  - Shared responsibility between City and business owners, leaning towards business owners:
     Keeping area clean, green spaces / flowers, street furniture
  - Work with councillor on in-progress Avenue Road traffic study
  - Raise issues of traffic, speeding, parking and rolling stops (Avenue Road and residential areas)

Residential: Dislike of large houses

- Continue addressing proposals at Committee of Adjustment
- Address issue with Councillor and Planning

# Enhancing the environment and social life

- Neighbours' Night Out
  - Relocate the event each year
  - Consider children's group performances
- Fall Fest on Avenue Road
  - Work with the Councillor (but he needs business owner involvement)
    - Annual event (not in 2020 due to COVID-19)
    - Expand scope south to Old Orchard or further
    - Earlier planning
    - More advertising
