



SAHRA Wish List for Section 37 Funds (May 2021)

Listed below but not limited to, is SAHRA's wish list for Section 37 money listed within priority A and B rankings:

PRIORITY A

Trees:

- Replenish and improve tree planting on Upper Avenue
- Improve the base arrangements for the trees
- Provide Tree Guards as necessary

Public Realm improvements on Upper Avenue (street lighting, benches, green areas, etc).

Transformation of paved boulevards currently permitted for boulevard parking to green areas with seating.

Encourage/motivate the shopkeepers on Avenue Road to provide seating areas by providing them with attractive benches.

Encourage/motivate all 'corner' shopkeepers to 'green' their areas with flower boxes and/or seating (perhaps provide them with attractive benches).

401 On/Off Ramps - require landscaping to provide an attractive transition into our Neighbourhood; planting of trees and low maintenance grasses - some of this may be funded by the Province (Ministry of Transportation) but may not be provided for the areas on the south side of the Highway.

"Gates" to Upper Avenue:

- Some meaningful artwork and/or signage to designate the "gate" to Upper Avenue at Lawrence
- Some meaningful artwork and/or signage to designate the "gate" to Upper Avenue at Wilson

Plaques at Historic Sites, as defined by the BPRO Histories.

Public Art (OCAD students could possibly participate):

- Street Art - Murals on selected street corner buildings on Avenue Road
- Statue of a noted/historical figure for North Toronto
- Street Sculpture

PRIORITY B

Bicycle/walking paths that could include other wards for an uptown/downtown route (tie in with Cycle Toronto).

Seniors Home improvement (Marjory Carton Apts) at 193 Wilson Ave - Toronto Housing for low income Seniors, if not funded by Toronto Community Housing or other sources.

Lawrence Park Collegiate improvement to the Sports Field , if not funded by TDSB.

Armour Heights Public School – any school yard improvements that should be made that would not be funded by TDSB or the PTA.

Armour Heights Community Centre - improvements to Library and Playground, if not funded by other sources.
